1. Plan a Swachh Bharat citizen meeting for your city
2. Schedule a Swachh Bharat event in your city Swachh Bharat circle
3. If you are not a member of your city’s Swachh Bharat circle, look it up at: <http://tinyurl.com/Find-A-Circle> and join
4. If an Event is already created in your city Swachh Bharat circle, RSVP for that event
5. Meet with the circle members on Independence Day, August 15th
6. Review the following city issues as applicable:
 - a. Workings of the Urban Local Body/Municipality
 - b. Garbage Pick Up
 - c. Clean up of Streets
 - d. Water Logging Issues
 - e. Availability of Public Toilets
 - f. Waste Disposal
 - g. Plan visit to Municipal Commissioner
 - h. Creating awareness about Civic Sense
 - i. Projects the Swachh Bharat City Circle can take
 - j. Appoint 2 volunteers in circle to coordinate efforts
 - k. Define monthly meeting schedule
7. Plan a cleanliness drive (based on interest from members)
